



Reception Home Activities Friday 11th March

What a busy week! We have had a great time learning the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff. The children loved learning about mountain goats, mountains and valleys. We learnt the story through role play so ask them to show you their scariest troll impression! The children have used their phonics knowledge to write facts about goats as well as writing parts of the story!

Ask them to tell you the story ☺

Phonics: Thank you for practicing the sounds at home. We have already seen fantastic progress so keep up the great work! This week we have recapped some sounds we are finding tricky such as oa, ee, ai, igh, ow, oi and ur. Please focus on these in words over the weekend. We have also learnt a few more tricky words to read: said, so, from, went and recapped was and are.

Maths: We have been learning about size of objects as well as size of numbers this week and been using lots of comparative language. The children sequenced the goats from the story and described each one. We then moved on to sequencing numbers on goats from 1 to 20. The challenge this week was to sequence 4 goats which had different numbers on their tummies e.g. 10, 15, 7 and 22. The children had to put them in order of size. Can they find 5 things at home and put them in order? Can they use the vocabulary of small, big, smallest, biggest, smaller than, bigger than to describe them.
