



Reception Home Activities Friday 17th June

We have had great fun learning even more interesting facts about dinosaurs this week! We have been finding out how big they really were and doing lots of measuring. The children have also explored the sizes of dinosaur footprints which they found fascinating as their footprints were so much smaller! The children have enjoyed a range of dinosaur stories this week, especially one all about dinosaurs and underpants!

Phonics: We have been learning lots about how we can describe different dinosaurs, using adjectives to describe their size and what they look like. They have all designed their own dinosaurs and made up great dinosaur names! We even had a Tankosaurus who carried water in the tank on its back for all the other dinosaurs! Please ask the children to tell you some dinosaur facts they have learnt about during the past two weeks and focus on speaking their ideas in whole sentences. Keep practising the tricky sounds and key words the children have learnt so far; here, there, were and have are new words to learn.

Maths: Use the vocabulary relating to height and length to compare things they can see e.g. the house is taller than the tree, your foot is longer than my foot.
