



Reception Home Activities Friday 29th January

We have had a great time continuing the story of Stickman this week. We have thought about floating and sinking, and even enjoyed making our own game of Pooh sticks. All the children have made their very own Stickman this week and they look great displayed in the classroom.

Phonics: This week we have learnt week 4 of Phase 3. The sounds are oo, ee, ai, oa. We have blended these sounds to read and segmented to spell words with these sounds.

Word Lists

oo: moon, zoom, zoo, room, broom, loop

ee: sheep, sleep, feet, leek, tree

oa: boat, float, coach, goat, toast

ai: rain, paint, train, wait, drain

What other words can they think of with these sounds? We have also started to read captions such as 'The sheep was big, The boat can float' and the children are doing very well with this new challenge. The tricky words this week are: was, with, my, will.

Collective Worship: This week we have thought about our new Collective Worship Policy. Each day we have a time to reflect on a piece of music, our PATHS learning, our Home/School Books, a story with a moral or reflecting on our learning from the week. At the end of this time we think of a mission we can do the following day which reflects what we have thought about. This week our mission has been to share and take turns with someone else.

Maths: We have really enjoyed learning about tally charts this week and counting in fives. Maybe they can show you how to record tally marks and practice counting in fives 😊
