

## Maths

We will be learning to:

- Subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number crossing ten
- Add two 2-digit numbers not crossing ten
- Add two 2-digit numbers crossing ten
- Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number not crossing ten
- Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number crossing ten
- Bonds to 100 (tens and ones)
- Add three 1-digit numbers
- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p).
- Combine amounts to make a particular value.
- Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

## SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar)

The children will continue to have spellings to practise involving a new spelling rule they have learnt. Please support your children to learn these spellings which will be uploaded to the school website. The children will be learning their grammar knowledge through a high quality text 'Meerkat Mail' by Emily Gravett.

## PE

The children will be learning dance and gymnastics this half term. Please ensure your child has a named PE kit in school every day. This should include; a t-shirt, jumper, shorts, tracksuit bottoms and plimsolls. Also, ensure children with long hair have a hairband in school to tie their hair up for PE lessons.

# Year 2 Autumn 2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term Transport



## Topic

The children will be learning about different types of transport.

**History** – The children will be learning about the history of modern transportation including learning about the Wright Brothers and the first controlled flight.

**DT** - In DT the children will be designing, making and evaluating a toy vehicle.

**Science** – In Science the children be learning about different types of materials and their properties. They will investigate why products are made of certain materials.

**RE** – The children will be learning about how Christians around the world celebrate Christmas.

**Music** – The children will continue their African drumming lessons with Steve.

## English

The children will re-cap their knowledge of questions by asking questions to a visiting engineer from Lotus. They will be writing down facts they learn from his visit and also writing him a thank you letter.

The children will be writing a fact file about the Wright Brothers.

We will be using the book Meerkat Mail as a basis to learn about writing postcards, diaries and newspaper articles.

The children will be encouraged to use the spellings they have learned in spellings lessons in their writing. We will also focus on using conjunctions this half term to extend the children's sentences. We will be introducing the Conjunction Crew which are characters to help the children understand and engage with conjunctions e.g. Andy And, Bella Because, Oliver Or.
