

Maths

- Can you find some containers and order them from the largest capacity to the smallest capacity?
- Can you use a tally chart to collect information such as the most popular pet in your family? Remember to close the gate so you can count the gates in 5s.
- Can you practice your 2, 5 and 10 times tables?
- Can you practice saying the number pairs which make 10, and then 20?
- Can you practice adding together different coins and finding the totals?

PE

- Can you practice aiming a football at a goal? You could also defend the goal while a friend aims the ball.
- Can you invent a game to play outside with a friend? Think about how you could score points.

Reading

Remember to try and read with your child every evening for 10 minutes. You could use the sound mat on the school website to find different sounds while you are reading. We love to hear about the books you have been enjoying at home.
