

Homework activities to choose from- these will run all half term.

These are activities that you may choose to complete at home over the course of this half term. They are not compulsory. If you do choose to complete a Homework Activity, please bring it in on a Friday and we will aim to find time in the day to share it with the class.

Fireworks:

- Create some firework art
- Create a rocket out of an old kitchen paper tube

Celebrations/Festivals:

- Research and create a celebration fact file about a religious celebration you did not know about
- Draw/paint a picture of a celebration or festival you celebrate, or one you have found out about
- Tell us about a festival you have celebrated

Monkey See Monkey Do (storytelling in class week 2,3 and 4):

- Retell the story to someone at home
- Try to re-draw the story map. Can you add in some new ideas?
- Draw, paint, collage (choose a medium you like) a picture of a monkey, think about the background as well as the animal!

Diwali:

- Research Diwali and present your findings to the class- this could be a poster, collage, talk or factfile.
- Make or draw a Diva lantern
- Find out about one of the Hindu Gods- draw or write about them

Other:

- Write a book review of a book that you have enjoyed
- Practice your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Make sure you know your number bonds to 10 and 20. *eg. $9 + 1 = 10$, $8 + 2 = 10$ $19 + 1 = 20$*
