

Maths

- Can you practise adding and subtracting numbers to 20?
- Can you create arrays with different objects?
- Can you choose different numbers and work out 'one more' and 'one less'?
- Can you practise writing your numbers (to 100!) in numerals and words?
- Can you create different number sentences using the symbols + - and x (remember 3 x 4 is the same as 4 x 3)
- Keep practising your 2's, 5's and 10's timetables!

PE

- Can you practise your throwing and catching skills? See if you can make it harder by standing further away from a partner!
- Can you create a mini game of cricket? What skills are you going to need to play this game?

Reading

Remember to try and read every evening for 10 minutes. You could use the sound mat inside your reading diary to find different sounds while you are reading. We love to hear about the books you have been enjoying at home. Maybe you could write a review to recommend a book for us to read at school!

Topic

- Can you go on a plant hunt? See if you can identify and name different types of plants.

- Can you find a non-fiction text to help you learn facts about something that interests you? See if the book has a contents page, headings, diagrams and a glossary.

- Can you go on a suffix search? Look out for words ending in '-ed', '-er', '-est', '-es' and '-ing' in your favourite book.
