There are often spelling rules to help us remember how to spell words
(there are often exceptions to the rules-the english language is very tricky!)

Plurals 's', 'es' or 'ies'?

Most nouns can have 's' added to

If the noun ends in a 'ch', 'sh', 's' or 'x' most of the time add 'es'

If the noun ends in a vowel and a y most of the time we add 's'

But if the noun ends in a consonant and a 'y', replace the 'y' with 'ies'

Helpful tip!

Look at the word, cover it over, write it (don't peek!) and then check.
