Rule 1: possessive apostrophe for singular nouns

Rule 2: contractions - the apostrophe shows where a letter or letters would be if the words were written in full e.g. can't/ can not

It's means it is or it has but it's is never used for the possessive

Helpful tip!

Look at the word, cover it over, write it (don't peek!) and then check.
