There are often spelling rules to help us remember how to spell words

Rule 1: The 'y' is changed to an 'i' before -ed, er, est are added but not before -ing as this would result in 'iing'. The only ordinary words with 'ii' are skiing and taxiing.

Rule 2: The 'e' at the end of a root word is dropped before adding -ing, -ed, -er, -est, -y or when any other suffix with a vowel letter is added (exception- being)

Helpful tip!

Look at the word, cover it over, write it (don't peek!) and then check.
