


<p><u>PE:</u> This term we are again having PE lessons from the Norwich City Partnership team. They will deliver a games based curriculum. We will work on tennis in class. PE will be on a Monday and Wednesday.</p> <p>Ideally the children should have shorts, T-shirt and plimsolls, A spare pair of socks is also useful especially if the girls are still wearing tights. Please ensure that the children have a full kit in school that fits - there seemed to be lots of incomplete kits in school last term after the holiday! Thank you.</p>	<p><u>Art Attack!:</u> This half term we will be looking at art through time. We will start by looking at Artists in the Victorian times, linking in with last terms topic. The children will find out about art techniques as well as the different mediums used. We will even have ago at making our own master-pieces working individually, in pairs and groups.</p>	<p><u>Art History:</u> In week two we will be taking part in a whole school art history week. We have been given the decade of the 1960's. We will be finding out about events, art and music of this time. The focus for the whole week across the school will also be the Queen. If you, or any of your family members, have any memories or photos from the 60's to share in class we would love to share them- a memory slip will be coming home for any memories to be recorded on that you would like to share.</p>

The final group will begin later this term and will receive a letter before it is due to start with more details. The children have really been enjoying the rich experience.</p>	 <p>'Art Attack' Year 2 Summer term 1</p>	<p><u>Numeracy:</u> This half term we will be recapping on a bit of everything! The children need to work on their number facts (to know all number bonds to 10 so all the ways to make each number e.g. 5+1, 4+1,3+2, then moving onto numbers to 20. Also multiplication tables for 2, 5 and 10, then the corresponding division facts. We will also be looking at scales, when measuring, shape, calculation and problem solving.</p>
<p><u>Homework:</u> Please see the additional sheet with homework on. We haven't changed how we are doing homework this half term to make it easier to manage in class. There are, as before, some things that should be done regularly to support the child with their learning. There is then a list of additional homework. We are aiming to improve writing by working on different sorts of punctuation (!? '-to show possession, a contraction (do not/don't) and , -in lists)and writing for a variety of purposes. We will be encouraging the children to use different adjectives- this is something that could be helped when reading- look out for 'wow' words that the children could use in their own writing. The children will continue to take part in a short grammar lesson daily.</p>
<p><u>PATHS:</u> This will continue, helping the children to understand their own feelings (both comfortable and uncomfortable) and those of others.
