Grammar focus:

Word: Use of the forms a or an according to whether the next word begins with a consonant or a vowel [for example, a rock, an open box]. Sentence: Expressing time, place and cause using conjunctions [for example, when, before, after, while, so, because]. Text: Introduction to paragraphs as a way to group related material

Spelling focus: The /d_3/ sound spelt as ge and dge at the end of words, and sometimes spelt as g elsewhere in words before e, i and y. The /s/ sound spelt c before e, i and y. The /n/ sound spelt kn and (less often) gn at the beginning of words. Common exception words
