Year 3 Home Learning Expectations

We hope that your child has enjoyed their first few days in Year 3. We have been so impressed with their levels of maturity and attitude to learning already and are very much looking forward to the year ahead. We know that not all parents were able to visit the new classroom this week so we wanted to take the opportunity to share our expectations for home learning.

Spellings

Your child will come home with a red 'Homework and Spellings' book with their first set of spellings to learn. Every child should learn the Chilli Challenge 1 words. If your child needs a harder challenge they may learn the Chilli Challenge 2 or 3 words. They may only move on to a harder challenge once the other words have been learnt.

Your child will be tested on the Chilli Challenge 1 words (words they must know) plus any other they have learnt on Monday the following week. They will be tested in their red Homework & Spelling book so you can see how well they did and support them with any they struggled with.

Grammar

As well as spellings your child will also have a weekly grammar task in their red homework book. A new rule is introduced every Monday and will be referred to in literacy lessons where it is appropriate.

Times Tables

It is important that your child practices their times tables at home on a regular basis. This term we will focus on 2x, 5x and 10x table. We will spend time in class practicing these but also looking at how these can be used to help in other areas. To help with this you might like to practice some missing number problems such as:

$$\underline{\quad} \times 2 = 10 \text{ or } 3 \times \underline{\quad} = 15$$

Topic Homework Activities

Every half term the children will be given a variety of homework activities that link to their class topic. These are not compulsory but instead designed to give the children the opportunity to direct their own learning and be creative should they wish to.
