What a group of Superheroes we have had this week! We have been making masks, badges and writing stories about Superheroes. The children have talked about the different Superheroes they know. They are very knowledgeable! They have been outside, dressing up and acting out stories, building a Batmobile and Bat Caves! Ask your children to tell you what they know and maybe tell you a story.

Phonics

Unsurprisingly we have been writing about Superheroes. The children are becoming such confident writers now and using their phonics in their writing. We have been amazed. We have also shared stories with Superheroes which has also helped their story telling. Have you got any at home you can share?

As you know the children are in different groups for phonics and we practise reading and writing words each week. We are ensuring the children are remembering these words, which may take a few weeks of reinforcement. This week the words are:
