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Build Update

The main building project is now complete. Whilst there are still some smaller associated projects which will take place over the coming months (landscaping, snagging etc.), we are delighted that the main project is finished. It has been a challenging time and I'd like to thank all those involved for working together to make sure the impact on the children during the build was minimal. We are delighted with the finished product and the children are proud of their new school.

As part of the expansion of the site, we have looked carefully at parking and safety at the front of the school. As you will see, we have tried to ensure there is as much disabled parking as possible in front of the school and that there are clear designated safe crossing points for children as they exit the gate. We would ask parents who drive to collect and drop off children to please park a short distance away from the school and walk the final stage. We have clear markings on the school's slip road to ensure that parents do not park where children will be leaving the site. The 'deliveries only' area is not a parking bay to ensure children have clear visibility from the designated crossing area.

The council will be improving the parking restrictions on Sheffield Road to try to help keep the area directly outside the school clear to make road crossing and cycling as safe for our children as possible.

We thank you for your help in keeping Ashleigh's children safe.

World Book Day - Thursday 1st March

The £1 World Book Day tokens will be given out on 1st March to all children. These can be used either in exchange for the selected World Book Day books, or can be put towards any other book purchase. After school Ketts Books will be running a book fair with three tables; one offering the £1 World Book day books, one with general books for all ages, and a third selling Usborne books. For every two Usborne books purchased, Usborne will donate one to the school library. Children can come to school dressed as their favourite book characters, staff will be dressing up too!

School Library

We are really proud of our new school library and appreciative of all the fundraising efforts that have gone into restocking and improving our selections. To maintain this high standard we will be implementing a new system where lost books will be charged for if they cannot be found within a three week period. We are encouraging the children to take responsibility for their belongings and school resources, which we hope will also stand them in good stead for day to day life.

Sport for Schools Tokens

The EDP and Norwich Evening News have teamed up with Sports for Schools to kick-start a campaign which will see schools and communities collect tokens to win a share of a £20,000 sports kit cash pot.

From Monday 5th February until April, special tokens will be printed in every edition of the EDP and Evening News – and parents, school staff and the local community can collect and donate them.

The top three schools with the most tokens – calculated on a pro rata basis based on pupil numbers – will receive prizes of £5,000, £3,000 or £2,000, while schools which collect 1,000 tokens will receive a free sports pack.

Tokens will be printed in the paper every day from Monday, February 5 to Saturday, April 14.

There will be one token a day, as well as bonus tokens on occasion and two tokens every Saturday.

The school with the most tokens as an average of total pupils will mean all schools, regardless of size, will have a chance of winning.

Please send any tokens collected into school with your child, or post them in the token collection box that will be available in the school entrance.
