

## Year 2 Spellings Homework

This week we are learning about adding the -est and y suffixes to one syllable words with a short vowel and a single consonant. In this case the consonant is doubled before the suffix is added (short vowel, double consonant rule). e.g. big -> biggest or sun -> sunny

The common exception words we are learning this week are sure and sugar.

Please practise these spellings with your child throughout the week.
