English

In English we will be creating adventure stories which will be turned into books for next year's year 4 children. We will be looking at story structure, writing dialogue and building tension in our writing. Later in the term we will be using our Market topic to inspire some non-fiction writing and will be creating class poetry anthologies based on a number of well-known poems.

Topic

During this topic, children will use drama to travel through time and imagine how life in Norwich has changed through the ages. We will learn about the history of Norwich Market and the surrounding buildings over the last 900 years. Children will investigate primary and secondary historical sources, questioning their reliability and effectiveness. To finish, we will learn about how the market has changed in recent years and how it is used today.
