

English

We will be learning the story 'The Magic Shell' using the storytelling technique Talk for writing. The children will rewrite the story thinking of new characters, settings and objects. The children will then have a go at planning, telling and writing their very own wishing tale.

The children will continue to learn about the different types of sentences and apply them to their writing. Ask your child to explain what statement, command, question and exclamation sentence are.

We will use the knowledge gained in our Topic lessons about Grace Darling to write a fact file about her. We will also be learning about seaside safety and making a safety poster.

Maths

In maths we will be covering many different areas that we feel the children need to work on more before the entering Year 3. These will include: comparing and measuring volume, money, using the inverse to check calculations, fractions and the relationship between division and multiplication.
