#### **Important!**

Please, make sure that **all items of your child's clothing are clearly named, including shoes** - it is almost impossible to identify the owner of lost clothes otherwise. We will return all named items to children. Please also ensure that your child's coat has a strong hanging loop securely attached to it.

#### **Jewellery**

For reasons of security and safety, jewellery should not be worn. We recognise that there may be exceptions to this rule for cultural or religious reasons. In such instances please discuss your particular circumstances with the head teacher. Children should not wear earrings to school on days when they do PE unless they are able to remove them themselves. School staff are not permitted to remove or replace earrings. We recommend that any ear piercing takes place at the beginning of the summer holidays.
