We will learn to read and spell words which contain these sounds. We will also recap reading and writing the tricky words that they have previously covered.

Computing


In computing this term we will be:

English

English will include regular guided reading sessions at least once a week. Listen to your child read for 10 minutes every day. We will:

- revise the alphabet; recap letter names and sounds as well as the formation of letters.
- have regular story sessions and use a variety of texts, both non-fiction and fiction, to support learning in many areas of the curriculum.
- look at writing simple sentences using a capital letter at the beginning, fingers between each word and a full stop at the end.

Maths

Throughout Year 1 there will be a continued focus on reasoning and problem solving. We will also look for the children to explain how they have found their answer.

We use a maths mastery approach which means we begin the year by using small numbers to focus on place value and addition and subtraction strategies

This half-term we will be focusing on place value:

- Counting to 10
- Counting objects to 10
- Writing to 10
- Counting to 0
- Comparing numbers of objects
- Ordering numbers
- Comparing numbers

We will then move onto addition with numbers to 10:

- Number bonds
- Adding with number bonds
- Adding by counting on
- Completing number sentences
- Solving picture problems

PE
