### Make Tuttles Lane 30mph Campaign

- We are writing on behalf of a group of Wymondham residents who are concerned about the current speed limit along Tuttles Lane, and who have launched a new campaign: "Make Tuttles Lane 30mph".
- We have created a petition for residents to sign if they are in support of reducing the speed limit to 30mph:

- Local drivers have observed that it has become more difficult and dangerous to negotiate the junctions with Barnham Broom Road, Melton Road and Hewitts Lane and many pedestrians feel unsafe walking along the road. We are particularly concerned about children walking to school, especially as the volume of traffic increases, and want to make Wymondham safer for everyone.
