This week

We based our learning around the book "Dear Zoo". The children have enjoyed making their own Dear Zoo pictures, painting animal pictures and listening to lots of animal stories.

In phonics we have been "robot talking", words such as "peg" and "cup", splitting words up into their sounds and saying these one at a time – a bit like a robot; p-e-g. This supports early segmenting and blending skills, as children begin to read and write.

In maths we learnt about estimating, having a sensible guess. We estimated how many children were in Nursery each day and have had a go at estimating challenges throughout the week. The children were great at having a sensible guess – try this at home, estimating how many letters through the door, how many flowers growing or how many peas on your plate.
