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Mobile Phones in School

We are aware that some of the older children carry mobile phones to and from school. Wherever possible, we would discourage children from bringing phones on to the school premises. If a phone has a camera and access to the internet via a mobile phone connection, it can present a safeguarding risk. If, however, parents feel it is necessary for the older children walking on their own to have a phone, we would like to clarify:

- A child's phone should be turned off and in their bag before they enter the school premises i.e. before they pass through the school gate. Any children using phones on the playground in the morning will have them confiscated.
- Children must hand their phone to their class teacher to be stored and request it back at the end of the day. It is the child's responsibility to remember to request the phone at the end of the day. Whilst the phone will be safely stored we cannot accept liability for any loss or damage.
- We would suggest that if a child needs a phone for their walk to/from school it should be a basic model, ideally without internet connection. This safeguards your child further by reducing the likelihood of theft during their journey and restricting unmonitored internet use.
- If a child ignores the expectations set out above their phone will be confiscated. For any repeat offenders this will require an adult to collect it from the school office.

From the school's perspective, we would rather children do not bring phones on site. Please only allow your child do to so if you feel it is vital and they can adhere to the expectations set out above.

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Norfolk Welcomes - Friday 14th June



On Friday 14th June, we will be taking part in Norfolk Welcomes. On that day in schools across the county, children and young people will be learning about the experiences of refugees, both today and in the past, and helping to build a culture of welcome in our communities.

Norfolk has a long and rich history as a place of sanctuary and refugee communities have contributed enormously to our shared culture and heritage. Many individuals and groups of people have come to Norfolk over the centuries seeking sanctuary. This year the theme and inspiration for Norfolk Welcomes will be The Strangers': a group who came to Norwich from the Spanish Netherlands as economic migrants and refugees in the 16th century. The Strangers brought with them new weaving techniques and materials that helped to enrich Norwich as it grew to become the second city in Tudor England. Among other things, The Strangers also introduced the printing press, butter, canaries and hopped ale to the county.

We will be holding a non-uniform day on 14th June and pupils are welcome to wear green and/or yellow, and make a suggested donation of £1.

All the money donated will go towards New Routes, to provide short-term financial support to refugees and asylum seekers in Norwich.
