Medicine in School

- ALL medicine in school must be kept in the school office (or, in agreed circumstances, a locked classroom cupboard).
- No child should have any medication with them, whether in a pocket, school bag, lunchbag or locker.
- School policy is designed to keep all children safe in school. We are required to log time, date and amount of medicine administered on every occasion.
- Prescribed medicine can be administered when handed in with a completed Consent to Administer Medicine Form. Forms are available from the school office.

Year 3 Trip to Easton - Wednesday 12th June

- All children will need to come into school with a jumper/fleece or cardigan as their arms will need to be covered. They will also need to wear either school trousers or PE tracksuit bottoms. Children should come into school with normal school shoes on but will need to bring a carrier bag to put their wellies in to take with us.
- Parent helpers will also need to be wearing long sleeves and trousers and to bring wellies separately to the shoes they are wearing.
- As we are visiting a farm with lambs in the fields that we are crossing, anyone who may be pregnant will have to work with the indoor group at that point, to keep them safe.
