Summer Fun Outdoors

- Visit your local woodland - Ashwellthorpe wood and Long's Wood in Wreningham are great places to go for a walk. See how many types of wild flowers you can see, perhaps find a sit spot and see how many sounds you can hear. Remember if you are visiting a woodland this summer to leave no trace other than foot prints.
- Visit the beach - take part in a two minute beach clean. Some beaches provide bags for this so have a look when you are there. Do keep safe by not picking up broken glass or other unsafe looking rubbish. Ask a grown up if you're not sure. Perhaps you could collect pebbles and drift wood and create some beach art or, if you are going to Cromer, check out the rock pools to see what is living in them.
