School Lunches - Nursery, Years 3-6 via Wisepay

You will need to access Wisepay via the Wisepay logo displayed on the right hand side of the school website: www.ashleighprimary.com

- If you need a copy of your log-in details, please contact the school office.
- Please pre-book for week commencing Monday 14th October by midnight on **Sunday 13th October.**
- If your child is ill on a day you have pre-booked a meal, please contact the office with details of a lunch you would like to book in its place. **Meals need to be rearranged within one week of the period of absence.**
- **If you forget to order school meals before midnight on Sunday please send your child/ren with a home packed lunch that week.**

Flu Vaccinations Reception to Year 6

- An email was sent home on Friday 13th September with all the necessary information about the new way for parents/carers to **consent/decline the vaccine through the online portal.** **The portal will close on 28th October.**

- Please contact 0300 555 5055 if you have already consented to nasal flu using the portal **AND your child has been in Intensive Care due to their Asthma.**
