### English

This half term we will be writing some persuasive letters to teachers, asking them to take part in SWITCH OFF day. We will also be completing some descriptive and recount work based on the picture book 'Tuesday' by David Wiesner

### Computing

This term in computing children will be learning about e-safety. They will then look at coding, programming different items to move following a set path.

### Design & Technology

This term in DT we will be creating a healthy snack. The children will evaluate existing snacks according to their taste, smell, texture, appearance and how healthy they are. They will then be creating their own and evaluating it.

### Science

This half term we will be learning about the human body with a specific look at the digestive system. We will explore the organs involved in the process and identify their individual functions. We will then explore human teeth and discuss the different roles each type plays in the early stages of digestion.

The children will then explore their understanding with an enquiry that they will formulate themselves about teeth hygiene, learning how to conduct a 'fair test'.

### Art

This term, we will be looking at some Great British artists. We will be looking at different art movements and recreating some famous works. We will use aspects of other artists work to develop and create our own pieces.

We will be looking closely at the work of David Hockney. We will create our own images taking inspiration from his methods, use of colour, style and techniques.

We will also be looking at the work of Lowry and working together to create a collaborative piece of art for the KS2 corridor.
