This week has been the start of our spider topic. The children have been fascinated to learn all about spiders. We began the week reviewing what we already knew about spiders and what we wanted to find out, then the children explored lots of spider and spider web challenges in their independent play and learning. The children's amazing artwork is displayed in both classrooms, so do have a look on your way through.

Next Week

We will continue our spider topic but focus more on counting and number problems. Spiders are great for maths! We will be practising our careful counting skills to add legs and eyes to spiders, rolling a dice to see how many flies are caught in webs, sorting spiders and building web patterns.

Word of the Week

Each week we will be introducing a new word linked to our topic. We will focus on the word, what it means and using it confidently in sentences.

This week the word of the week is "catch". We noticed how a spider can catch its food in a web; we practised playing catch and saying "good catch" when our friends caught the ball.

Learning Links at Home

- Can you play "catch" at home? You could use a soft toy, ball or a balloon.
