This Week

We continued our spider topic this week, the children enjoyed singing and clapping along to spider songs and nursery rhymes. We have been practising our careful listening skills and using instruments in the classroom to increase awareness of rhythm and different sounds.

We made spider crackers, carefully counting out 8 legs to add to our spiders. The children particularly enjoyed eating these as a snack! During their independent learning the children have practised their careful scissor skills, and developed fine motor skills through folding card to make bendy legs for their spider hats.

Next Week

We have a short topic about the story of The Gingerbread Man. The children will be joining in with telling the story, noticing the characters and predicting what might happen next. We will make and decorate Gingerbread people in our cooking.

In maths we will be noticing patterns and shapes. The children will use shapes to decorate their Gingerbread characters and will begin to name 2d and 3d shapes.

Word of the Week

Each week we will be introducing a new word linked to our topic. We will focus on the word, what it means and using it confidently in sentences.

This week the word of the week was "**delicate**". We noticed how some objects are delicate, easily broken. We found delicate objects such as shells, spider webs and petals.

Ask your child about the word delicate and see if they can find something delicate at home.

Birthday treats

Sometimes children bring in sweets/treats from home to give out to celebrate their birthdays. As we have children with various allergies, we always give these out at the end of the session when their parent/carer is present so that they are able to decide if their child can take one. If you are unsure please check with a member of staff at the time.

Bottles

Water bottles should contain **water** only.
We are a healthy school and make sure children have access to water and their milk entitlement throughout the sessions.
We also have children with various allergies and we need to be sure we only have water contained in the bottles.
