This Week

Welcome back and Happy New Year! We were so impressed with the way the children effortlessly remembered their Nursery routines this week.

We started our Bears topic by basing our learning around the traditional tale Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We acted out the plot and read several different versions of the story, noticing the differences in the text and illustrations in each.

In cooking the children have enjoyed making and tasting porridge. In their independent learning they have been practising their fine motor skills – using scissors and having a go at drawing bears to develop their pen control.

In maths we have compared the sizes of bears, chairs and beds using size vocabulary.

In phonics we began to notice initial sounds in words, we made “silly soup”, a soup which can only have ingredients beginning with a certain sound.

Next Week

We will move on to read lots more bear stories.

As our “bug in the jug” treat the children are welcome to bring a favourite teddy from home next week to introduce to the class. Please make sure any teddies are clearly named!

Alternatively, you could add a picture of your teddy to Tapestry and we will print these pictures and share with the class, or you could draw one for our art wall or bring in a bear story from home.
