This week

We have begun learning about Autumn, thank you for all the wonderful Autumn finds so far, the children really enjoyed exploring them. We enjoyed listening to Autumn stories and exploring leaves, conkers, acorns, and seeds. The children looked very closely at leaves; noticing the lines and colours that they could see. In our independent learning we have explored leaf rubbings, collage using leaves and printing using autumnal colours. In maths this week we have enjoyed counting and counting backwards through number rhymes and songs.

Next week

We will continue our Autumn topic by going on short walks around the nursery garden and school field to look for signs of Autumn. We will be tuning into sounds next week, listening to environmental sounds and exploring quiet and loud sounds outside. In our maths we will start to learn to count carefully, remembering to point to each object one at a time, go slowly and say each number name as we count.

Tapestry

Hopefully, you will have received a link to sign up for Tapestry. Tapestry will be used to capture your child's individual learning progress. We will continue to use Seesaw for whole class learning updates. We will begin to add observations from next week.

School Money

Gardening donations

If you have had a child at Ashleigh Nursery before you will remember our cooking activities and donation requests. This year, due to current guidelines, we won't be cooking just yet. But we hope to replace this with gardening activities, the children absolutely love our garden and it needs lots of care after the lockdown closure period!

Our plans include starting a wildflower area, bulb planting, revamping our allotment space, creating a herb area in tyre planters, and getting involved in planting seasonal produce on the school farm. If you can donate seeds, spring bulbs or even cuttings we would be very grateful for these.
