<p>Ensure if a member of staff is displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• stay at home and arrange a test asap.• stay at home until test results are received.• return to school the following day, if test is negative.• continue to stay at home for at least 10 days, if test is positive.	<p>Ensure if your child is displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• stay at home and you will arrange a test for them asap.• stay at home until test results are received.• return to school the following day, if test is negative.• continue to stay at home for at least 10 days, if test is positive.
<p>Ensure if a member of staff is living with someone who is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• stay at home and self-isolate• seek to get family member tested.• return to school the following day, if test is negative.• stay at home and self-isolate for 14 days, if test is positive. If during this time, symptoms develop, they will get tested and follow points 1-4 above.	<p>Ensure if your child is living with someone who is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• stay at home and self-isolate• wait for family member to get tested.• return to school the following day, if test is negative.• stay at home and self-isolate for 14 days, if test is positive. If during this time, symptoms develop, they will get tested and follow points 1-4 above.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide disposable cups for children who may have forgotten their bottle. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updated intimate care policy to ensure the safety of both child and pupil. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure child's uniform/ clothes are labelled. • Provide my child with a spare set of clothes which should be kept in child's school bag. • Ensure child wears their PE kit on days they have PE.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide children with all necessary resources. • Where possible, resources will be labelled to ensure they are used by one child only. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not allow my child to take into school any unnecessary items e.g. equipment, toys, show & tell objects etc.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure there are hand sanitiser points around the school. • Ensure children and adults sanitise on entry to the school building. • Ensure that handwashing takes place for all staff and children at regular points throughout the day. • Assist with verbal support and encouragement whilst maintaining distance. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reinforce the importance of hand-washing at home. • Support child so that they are able to do wash their hands (with warm water, soap and for 20 seconds) independently at school.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teach children the importance of respiratory hygiene using the 'catch-it, bin-it, kill-it' campaign. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reinforce the importance of respiratory hygiene using the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' campaign.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Procedures in place to avoid congestion and for parents to maintain social distancing during pick up and drop off. • Teach children about social distancing in an age appropriate way. We will teach children the importance of social distancing in school and outside of school. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure only one parent/carer attends school to drop off and collect child. (Those parents/carers that fall into a vulnerable group, may wish to avoid attending school. If this is not possible, they should observe strict social distancing, as per government advice. Those classified as Extremely Critically Vulnerable should not drop off or collect). • Follow social distancing guidelines on the school playground and when walking to and from school. • Remind children, who walk home on their own, the importance of social distancing with friends.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Telephone calls will be used instead of face to face meetings with staff and/or parents. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only enter the school building for essential reasons e.g. illness or safeguarding factors.
