### Roman Britain



#### Times tables!

We will be assessing children's times tables and completing regular times table challenges. We recommend you practise your times tables at home daily to ensure you make good progress. Times Table Rockstars is a wonderful free resource the children are already subscribed to. If you need more information about it, please don't hesitate to ask one of the Year 4 teachers!

#### The Romans homework ideas:

- Research the Romans and present your findings. This could be in the form of a poster, video, information text etc. You could research some of these areas: The Roman Empire, Roman daily life, Roman jewellery, entertainment, Roman Army, Boudicca, Invasion of Britain or Emperor Claudius.
- Draw and label the items worn and carried by the Roman Army.
- Design a Roman shield. You could even make one!
- Write the Roman numerals 1-20, 1-50 or even 1-100!
- Create a Roman mosaic using paper tiles.



#### English ideas:

- Write a description of the day Vesuvius erupted.
- Write a diary entry from a Roman soldier to explain what life was like in the Roman Army.
- Write a diary entry from the point of view of a Celt during the Roman invasion.
- Create a fact file or information booklet about an aspect of Roman life. (Army, Invasion, Daily Life, Leisure, Baths, Roads...)

These are activities that you may choose to complete at home over the course of this half term. They are not compulsory. If you do choose to complete a Homework Activity, please bring them in any day and we will endeavour to find time in the day to share the homework completed.

#### **Compulsory homework includes:**

Regular times table practice  
Regular reading out loud with an adult  
Maths Homework- set weekly from the maths homework book.
