### **Bring me Sunshine**



- Draw a flower and label the parts.
- Plant your own seeds and keep a diary of how they are growing.
- Read stories all about gardens, plants, growing, the weather.
- Could you create a story about a seed who grew using a story mountain? See below.
- Recall facts we learnt about the 4 UK countries. What have you remembered?
- Make a poster showing what a number to 40 looks like in tens frames, with Numicon, with objects, the numeral and how you write it in words.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. Can you start at a different number and count on?
- Make a weather report.
- Talk about the weather and how does it change our lives? What does different weather do for us?
- Do other countries have different weather? How could you find out?
- Could you draw a poster and explain how the weather helps plants to grow?
- Or a poster about the different types of weather.
- Practise your yoga from last term. Could you create a flow of movements using these?

These are activities that you may choose to complete at home over the course of this half term. They are not compulsory.
