This week

This week we have started learning all about Autumn. Thank you for the wonderful Autumn treasures that the children have been bringing into Nursery; they have really helped the children to notice all the seasonal changes around us.

In our sound games this week we listened to crunchy leaves and made leaf rattles. The children also had a go at potato printing and on the farm children collected leaves to make beautiful Autumnal trees.

In maths we focused on becoming really confident at counting to 5, we've been counting and matching, singing counting rhymes and songs and reading counting stories. Children have been learning that Autumn is a season, and that there are some signs of Autumn we can spot at this time of year.

Next week

We continue learning about Autumn, we will continue making leaf rattles and we will also make sound shakers using pasta/rice.

We hope to go on an Autumn walk (around the Nursery garden and school field) to listen for sounds and spot some signs of Autumn appearing.
