



## Ashleigh Primary School & Nursery Home-School Agreement during COVID-19

As a school, we will:	As a parent/carer, I will:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure staff check their temperature at home before coming into school if they are feeling unwell.</li><li>• Ensure staff stay at home for at least 7 days if they are showing any symptoms of coronavirus.</li><li>• Ring home immediately, if you child begins to show signs of coronavirus.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check my child's temperature at home before sending them to school if they feel unwell</li><li>• Keep my child at home if they are showing any of the main symptoms of coronavirus as stated in government guidance (below):<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>high temperature</b> – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)</li><li>• <b>new, continuous cough</b> – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)</li><li>• <b>loss or change to your sense of smell or taste</b> – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal</li></ul></li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Take the temperature of any child who is feeling unwell in school.</li><li>• Ring parent/carer immediately if child begins to show signs of coronavirus whilst in school.</li><li>• Isolate any child or member of staff who is showing symptoms of coronavirus in designated room.</li><li>• Call 999, if child is seriously ill.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Collect child immediately if school has phoned to say that child is showing signs of coronavirus.</li></ul> <p><i>Siblings will also need to be collected to ensure the whole family can self-isolate.</i></p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure any staff showing symptoms of coronavirus are tested to make sure isolation only takes place if completely necessary.</li> <li>• Ensure that parents are made aware that a teacher is absent due to having symptoms and it is then their choice whether they put their child into isolation until the test confirmation has come through;</li> </ul> <p><i>In the event that a teacher or child has a confirmed case of Covid-19, the children and staff within that 'bubble' will be asked to isolate for 14 days and to remain off school for that period.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure my child is tested if they are showing symptoms of coronavirus to make sure isolation only takes place if completely necessary. Testing needs to happen within the first 5 days of having symptoms. More information can be found here: <a href="https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test">https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test</a></li> </ul> <p><i>In the event that a teacher or child has a confirmed case of Covid-19, the children and staff within that 'bubble' will be asked to isolate for 14 days and to remain off school for that period.</i></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure staff self-isolate at home for at least 14 days if a member of their household is showing symptoms of coronavirus.</li> <li>• Ensure staff self-isolate at home for 14 days if a member of their school 'bubble' (child or member of staff) has tested positively for coronavirus.</li> <li>• Staff will self-isolate at home for at least 7 days if they develop symptoms during this time.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure my child self-isolates at home for 14 days if a member of our household is showing symptoms of coronavirus.</li> <li>• Ensure my child self-isolates at home for 14 days if a member of their school 'bubble' (child or member of staff) has tested positively for coronavirus. (School will notify parents if this was to happen).</li> </ul> <p><i>If a member of the bubble is showing symptoms of coronavirus and is awaiting test results, parents will be notified and it is up to parents to decide whether to isolate their child until test results are received.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If my child develops symptoms of coronavirus, I will ensure they self-isolate at home for at least 7 days from the day that symptoms show.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ring parent/carer of any child who is absent from school where we are expecting them to attend.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inform us of your child's absence if we were expecting them in.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inform the school if you/any member of your family are showing symptoms of coronavirus.</li> <li>• Ensure I do not enter the school site if I am showing symptoms of coronavirus.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure children's water bottles are organised a safe distance apart.</li> <li>• Ensure breaks are given throughout the day for drinks.</li> <li>• Teach children the importance of not sharing water bottles.</li> <li>• Provide disposable cups for children who may have forgotten their bottle.</li> <li>• Reintroduce lunch provision when we feel it is safe to do so.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Label my child's water bottle and packed lunch</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure staff wash clothes worn to school on a daily basis .</li> <li>• Updated intimate care policy to ensure the safety of both child and pupil.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure my child wears clean school uniform each day. During this transition period, we will allow children to wear non-uniform if they have no clean uniform available. Do not use clothing that is not machine washable.</li> <li>• Ensure child's uniform/ clothes are labelled.</li> <li>• Provide my child with a spare set of clothes which should be kept in child's school bag.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide children with all necessary resources.</li> <li>• Where possible, resources will be labelled to ensure they are used by one child only.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not allow my child to take into school any unnecessary items e.g. equipment, toys, show &amp; tell objects etc.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure children wash their hands on entry to school.</li> <li>• Ensure that handwashing will take place for all staff and children at regular points throughout the day</li> <li>• Monitor children washing their hands to ensure they wash with warm water, soap and for 20 seconds.</li> <li>• Assist with verbal support and encouragement whilst maintaining 2m distance</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reinforce the importance of hand-washing at home.</li> <li>• Support child so that they are able to do wash their hands (with warm water, soap and for 20 seconds) independently at school.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teach children the importance of respiratory hygiene using the 'catch-it, bin-it, kill-it' campaign.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reinforce the importance of respiratory hygiene using the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' campaign.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Procedures in place to avoid congestion and for parents to maintain social distancing during pick up and drop off.</li> <li>• Teach children about social distancing in an age appropriate way. We will teach children the importance of social distancing in school and outside of school.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure only one parent/carer attends school to drop off and collect child. (Those parents/carers that fall into a vulnerable group, may wish to avoid attending school. If this is not possible, they should observe strict social distancing, as per government advice. Those classified as Extremely Critically Vulnerable should not drop off or collect).</li> <li>• Follow social distancing guidelines on the school playground and when walking to and from school.</li> <li>• Not walk to school in large groups.</li> <li>• Not gather at entrance points or school doors.</li> <li>• Remind children, who walk home on their own, the importance of social distancing with friends.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff will not share lifts.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that only the same household members should travel together by car.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Follow social distancing guidance out of school hours.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Telephone calls will be used instead of face to face meetings with staff and/or parents.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only enter the school building for essential reasons e.g. illness or safeguarding factors.</li> </ul>
