### This week

The children enjoyed learning more about Autumn by taking a walk round the Nursery garden and school field, we spotted apples on the trees, berries, seeds, and leaves. We also met the chickens, who are new to the school farm this week. The Nursery children will help to collect the eggs and make sure the chickens have food and water daily. Can your child remember how many chickens there are (six!)? This week we have also begun our daily phonics learning. This starts with tuning in to environmental sounds and learning to listen carefully.

### Next week

We will compliment learning about sounds with the book "Peace at Last". In the story there are lots of sounds to explore. We will play lots of sound games to identify mystery noises.

### Tapestry

Tapestry is now up and running, hopefully your child will receive at least a weekly observation of their learning. When we speak to you at parent consultations, we will also let you know your child's key person and next steps.

### Session Availability


We have the following permanent spaces available:
