This week was pet week. We learnt that pets need food, water, care, love and exercise to stay healthy. This week we have practiced being really good listeners and having the confidence in talk in a larger group.

In maths we have been practicing counting out objects from a larger group, up to 10 objects.

Next week

We will continue the animal theme by basing our learning around animal stories. We will be creating our own “lift the flap” pages just like “Dear Zoo” and will be learning lots of early reading skills.

In maths we will introduce the children to estimating – having a sensible guess about how many people are here today, how many cubes I’m holding, how many packed lunches there are etc. We will then count to check if we were right.

In phonics we have been “robot talking” words such as “peg” and “cup”, splitting words up into their sounds and saying these one at a time – a bit like a robot; p-e-g. This supports early segmenting and blending skills, as children begin to read and write.
