This week

This week the children have enjoyed the start of our mini-beast topic, learning about ladybirds. We found out lots of interesting facts by looking at non-fiction texts. In maths the children practised their counting and estimating skills, we learnt to “see” the pattern of up to 6 spots, and to realise sometimes that when we can see a pattern we don’t need to count each one (this is the same skill as recognising dice patterns without counting). In phonics we played sound games to help the children to learn to hear the first sound in a word. This is a really good first skill to help with early reading and writing.

Word of the week

The word of the week was “first”. The children learnt what first means and we found the opportunity to use the word lots in our daily routines. Can you have a race at home and see who comes first?

Next week

We will learn all about worms! The children have made a wormery with Mrs Durrant during their farm sessions, so we will be using this carefully to observe how worms move and mix the soil. Worms are great for noticing details – we will learn how worms move and how their bodies are different to other mini-beasts. Worms are good for learning size vocabulary, will we compare lengths of (pretend) worms to practise using the words longer/shorter to describe length. In phonics we will be continuing our work on hearing initial sounds.

We have quite a collection of lost property, please ask if you think you may have lost something at Nursery. We will also put the boxes outside at collection time for you to have a look.

Sunny weather

We are all very pleased the weather has finally become warmer and we can enjoy the outside areas even more! We are outside much of the day at Nursery so please make sure your child has a sun hat if needed and sun cream applied **before** Nursery.
