## Facts and Knowledge

Different birds and animals lay eggs. Their babies hatch from the eggs. Eggs are fragile and need to be looked after. Different birds and animals look after their eggs in different ways. I wonder what you could find out about this at home?

The lifecycle of a frog begins with eggs called frogspawn, then tadpoles, then froglets and finally frogs. Do you know any other life cycles? Which ones?

Signs of Spring include buds on the trees, flowers growing, lambs being born... Are there any more you can remember or see on your walks?
